



RAPID ON-SITE METHAMPHETAMINE (ICE) TESTING WITH A RECORD KEEPING REPORTING APP FOR USED CAR DEALERSHIPS, FLEET VEHICLE OWNERS AND RENTAL CAR FRANCHISES

CAR DEALERSHIPS, FLEET VEHICLE OWNERS AND RENTAL CAR FRANCHISES NEED TO BE AWARE THAT IF THEY SELL, RENT OR ASSIGN A VEHICLE TO A BUYER, EMPLOYEE OR RENTER THAT IS METHAMPHETAMINE (ice) CONTAMINATED, THEY ARE **BREACHING THE HEALTH AND SAFETY REQUIREMENTS WHICH STATE "... It is the responsibility of all used car dealerships, fleet vehicle owners and rental car franchises to identify prior to selling, assigning or renting a vehicle, legally and morally, that it has no traces of methamphetamine contamination.

When used car dealerships assess a vehicle for trade-in or purchase, they carry out an inspection to determine how much they are prepared to offer the owner to ensure they are not about to purchase a lemon. Methamphetamine testing during this process will become a industry standard.



Associated with the marked increase in methamphetamine (ice) use in the community is that more and more users are consuming the drug in the relatively safe, secure and private confines of a vehicle.

The toxic fumes of their drug use are permeating and coating the hard surfaces and soft linings of the car. When a contaminated vehicle is traded or sold the contamination is passed on to the next unknowing owner.

Once these toxins become ingrained in the car's seats, ceiling, door linings and other surfaces of the vehicle they are virtually impossible to clean.

The danger increases when the interior of the car becomes hot, and residue re-vaporises and begins to release toxic compounds inside a vehicle and circulated continually by air conditioning.

In accordance with the health and safety requirements any methamphetamine contamination renders a vehicle unsaleable.

Dealerships etc become vulnerable to the possibility of legal action should they sell, assign or rent a contaminated vehicle and the new driver initiates a meth test which returns a positive result. This legal action could also include health associated issues of the driver or even health associated problems of passengers including family.

Meth Detecta testing can be completed in house and is the common-sense alternative to the expensive and time consuming testing alternatives currently available to the market but rarely utilised by dealerships, fleet companies or rental franchises so as to avoid call out fees of up to \$298.00 plus a fee per tested area of up to \$150.00.

Time consuming because dealerships etc cannot test in real time and are reliant on the availability of alternative testing processes.

Fleet vehicles and rental vehicles can be meth tested regularly at the office or upon return to the franchise.

Meth Detecta pricing is negotiable dependent on quantities with a start point of \$100.00.

A single "Meth Detecta" application allows a dealership or fleet owner to test an entire vehicle for traces of methamphetamine existence and create a historical report for future reference including protection should a customer initiate legal action associated with methamphetamine (ice) contamination.

Meth Detecta is a simple to use process that reports the test result in real time to a smartphone app.

Dealerships and fleet owners can instantly generate a result report for determination that can include pictures, time stamps and GPS location. Non - Editable PDF reports can be shared via email, Dropbox, text etc.

These reports can also be displayed in dealership stock as being methamphetamine tested and meth clean.

Dealerships and vehicle rental franchises who promote that they only sell or rent methamphetamine (ice) tested "meth clean" vehicles will benefit immediately in sales.
